SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT POLICY

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Blue Thunder Mining Inc. (“**Blue Thunder**” or the “**Company**”) is a gold exploration company focused in the Chibougamau Gold District of Québec, where it has consolidated approximately 51,000 hectares of prospective exploration claims in five separate blocks; Fancamp, Muus, Muus East, Embry, and Nisk.

This policy outlines our commitment to conduct exploration activities for the purpose of discovering and developing mineral deposits and for the potential eventual construction and/or operation of mines in a manner that supports a sustainable vision and promotes the core Blue Thunder values of Respect, Safety, Teamwork, Transparency and Integrity. Our sustainability commitments are summarized below.
